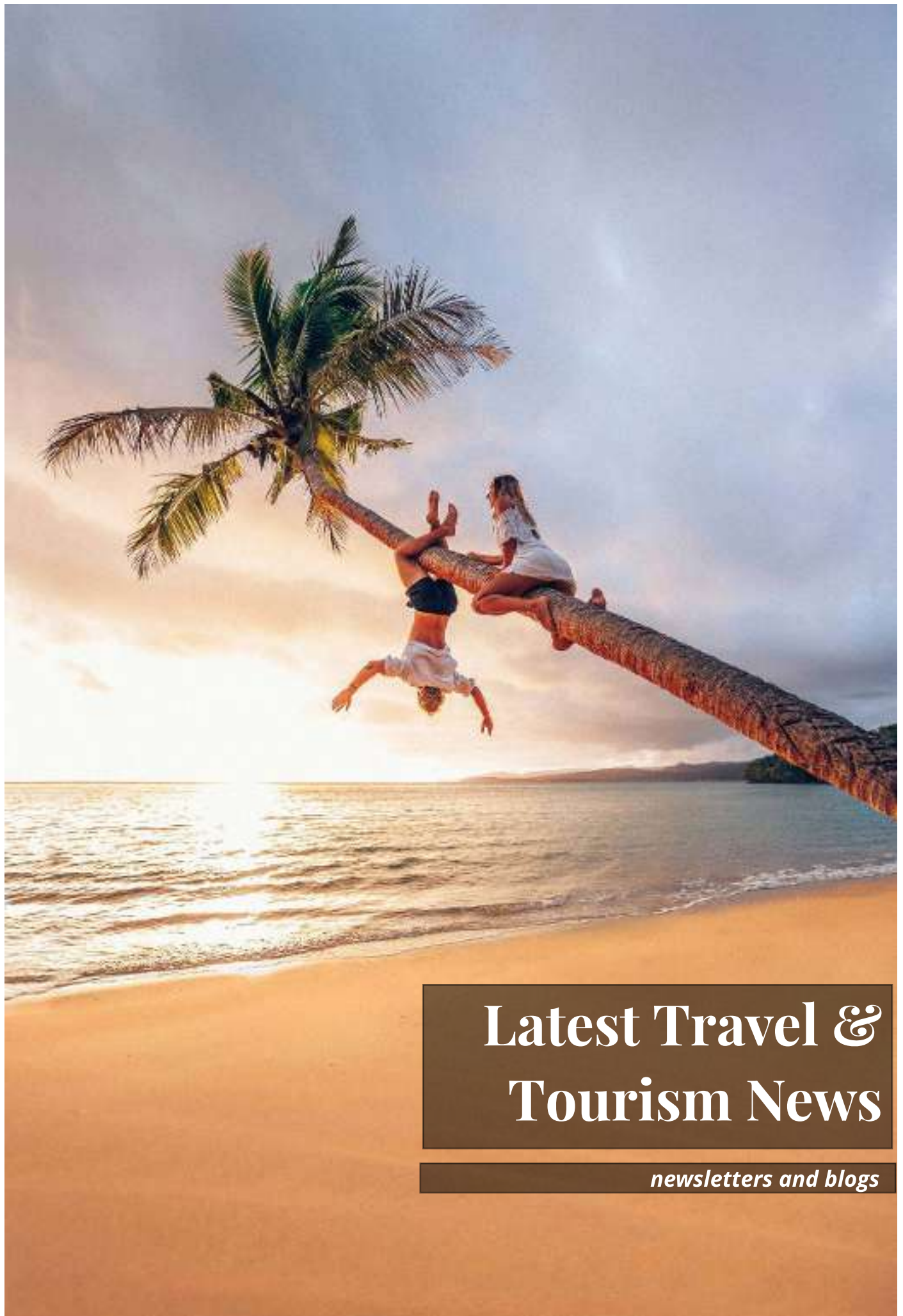

Plantation Island | New Dining Options

Plantation Island Resort in Fiji will open the new **Tavola Restaurant & Bar** on 1 September 2019. This will provide a new a la carte breakfast option to guests, complementing the buffet breakfast offering at Ol Copra Shed Restaurant. Tavola Restaurant will be open for breakfast from 7:30am to 10:30am daily and will then be open for all day dining from 11am to 9pm daily.

Black Coral Restaurant will be renamed Black Coral Grill. It will offer a selection of local and imported meats and seafood from the char grill, along with hot-rock options.

The Snack Bar will offer a range of grab 'n' go options such as wraps, paninis and hot dogs from 10am to 4pm daily and takeaway pizzas only will be offered from 4pm to 6pm. Pizza will also be on the menu at Tavola Restaurant. Plantation Island Resort's Kids Eat Free offer is for two kids 12 years and under to eat free from specific outlets. From 1 September, resort guests will be given a Dining Guide on arrival which will outline the offering at each outlet, the opening times, the kids eat free policy and meal plan inclusions.



RHUM-BA RUM & ORANGE CAKE

- Gluten Free
- Ingredients
- Serves: 10
- 2 oranges, about 280g; scrubbed & roughly chopped (with skin)
- 5 eggs, separated
- 200 g (7 oz) caster sugar
- 225 g (8 oz) ground almonds
- 2 tbsp flaked almonds
- 4 nips white rum
- 1 x Orange peel
- 1 x Cinnamon stick
- 250gm Sugar
- 1 litre water
- Icing sugar for dusting
- Sifted icing sugar to decorate

Method

Prep:1hr › Cook: 55min › Ready in: 1hr 55min

- Put the chopped oranges in a small saucepan, discarding any pips. Add 1 tbsp water, then cover and cook gently for 30 minutes or until the oranges are soft and excess liquid has evaporated. Leave to cool.
- Preheat the oven to 180°C (350°F, gas mark 4). Line the bottom and sides of a 23 cm (9 in) springform cake tin with baking parchment. Finely chop the oranges in a food processor or blender, or with a large knife.
- Put the egg whites in a large bowl and whisk until they form stiff peaks. Gradually whisk in half the caster sugar, then whisk for 1 minute.
- Using the same whisk, whisk the egg yolks with the remaining caster sugar in another bowl for 2–3 minutes or until pale and quite thick. Whisk in the finely chopped oranges, then carefully fold in the ground almonds.
- Stir in 3 spoonfuls of the whisked egg white to loosen the mixture, then gently fold in the remaining whites with a large metal spoon. Transfer the mixture to the prepared tin and level the top. Sprinkle with the flaked almonds.
- Bake for 50–55 minutes or until the cake is golden and a skewer inserted in the centre comes out clean. Check the cake after 20 minutes and again at 30 minutes, and cover lightly with foil if it is browning too quickly.
- Leave the cake to cool in the tin, then turn it out, peel away the lining paper and transfer to a serving plate. Dust with icing sugar before serving. The cake can be kept in an airtight tin for up to 2 days.
- Boil sugar water orange peel cinnamon stick together for 25 minutes to make stock syrup. Stock should feel oily rubbed between two fingers. Add rum, then soak sponge leave to settle and using icing sugar and stripes of paper dust on pattern.

Giovanna was a part of the ADI Cakobau School Cheerleading team at the Coca Cola Games Fiji, 3 years in a row. Giovanna auditioned for VOU Dance Company in November 2018 and joined the company full time. FIJI UNTOLD is her first full length production. "Gio" is a current Diploma student at the Conservatorium of Dance, Fiji.

Giovanna hopes that the Fiji Untold show will inspire our community to go back to their roots. **"Because I feel I missed out a lot growing up and I want to encourage the youth to delve into your roots before we loose it".**

Giovanna continues, **"My grandfather was a traditional Rotuman choreographer, and eventually my dream is to follow in his footsteps of creatling traditional Rotuman dances called Tautonga, and brining with this my experience as a contemporary dancer."**

On Fiji Islands – Suva – Chapter 2

An old yellow two-storey building across from the city market; letters along the balcony: HOTEL METROPOLE. The only door I could see gave entrance to a stand-up beer hall with a wet floor, some full-size billiard tables, and a multitude of tough looking Fijians holding cues with the graceful menace of men who still fish with spears.

"Around the corner and up the stairs," Derek said briskly.

At the top of a steep flight was a landing and a paneled glass wall pierced by a small embrasure like the cashier's wicket in an old bank. RING FOR SERVICE, said one sign; ALL ACCOUNTS ARE TO BE PAID ON CHECK-IN, said another. Derek rang. An elderly Indian appeared, recognizing him immediately.

"Welcome back sah."

"Hello, Hari."

Hari produced a registration card.

"Put down seven days," Derek said expansively.

"Are we really going to be here that long?" I whispered.

"Probably. "

Hari took us down a long passage with dusty yellow and grey walls. The carpet was red only at the edges, worn in the middle like a shortcut across a lawn.

"Bathroom here sah." Hari pointed at a mahogany door to a room already identified by an ammoniacal smell.

"Room six sah. Your old room." Hari ushered us in obsequiously. There was an odour of must and insect killer. Above the beds were gibbet-like frames that seemed to have been put up for the

benefit of suicides-supports for absent mosquito nets. The other fur-nishings were from a Pinter play: a ripped armchair, a dresser with a cracked glass top, and in one corner a washbasin so scoured that patches of cast iron showed through the enamel.

Derek turned on the overhead fan, sat down on the bed nearest the window, and sighed contentedly. **"Number six. Lots of memories. Christine and I had this room when she came to visit me."**

"You brought her here?"

"Everybody who came to visit stayed at the Metropole. It became something of a tradition."

I was relieved when Derek suggested we go out onto the balcony at the front of the building for a beer. I needed a drink. I'd stayed in much worse hotels, but not by choice. Before leaving the room I opened a dresser drawer; two large cockroaches ran out.

"Cockroaches are a fact of life here," Derek said.

No doubt.

The balcony I recognized from Derek's reminiscences on many a Canadian winter night. When it was thirty or forty below zero outside, we would open a bottle of brandy, watch his Fiji slides, and talk quietly of warm tropical evenings. But here in Suva it was still rush hour, and we had to shout above the roar of Leyland buses. One of the things I always forget about the Third World is the noise. From the wharf at the end of the street reared the superstructure of a cruise liner, its monumental whiteness dominating the ram-shackle market and waterfront. Across from the Metropole rose another eminence-the office block and department store of the Burns Philp South Sea Company, built in such period art deco that the stucco "1930" on the facade was hardly necessary. The main entrance was on the corner, beneath a tower capped by a steep tiled roof suggestive in outline of Fijian architecture.

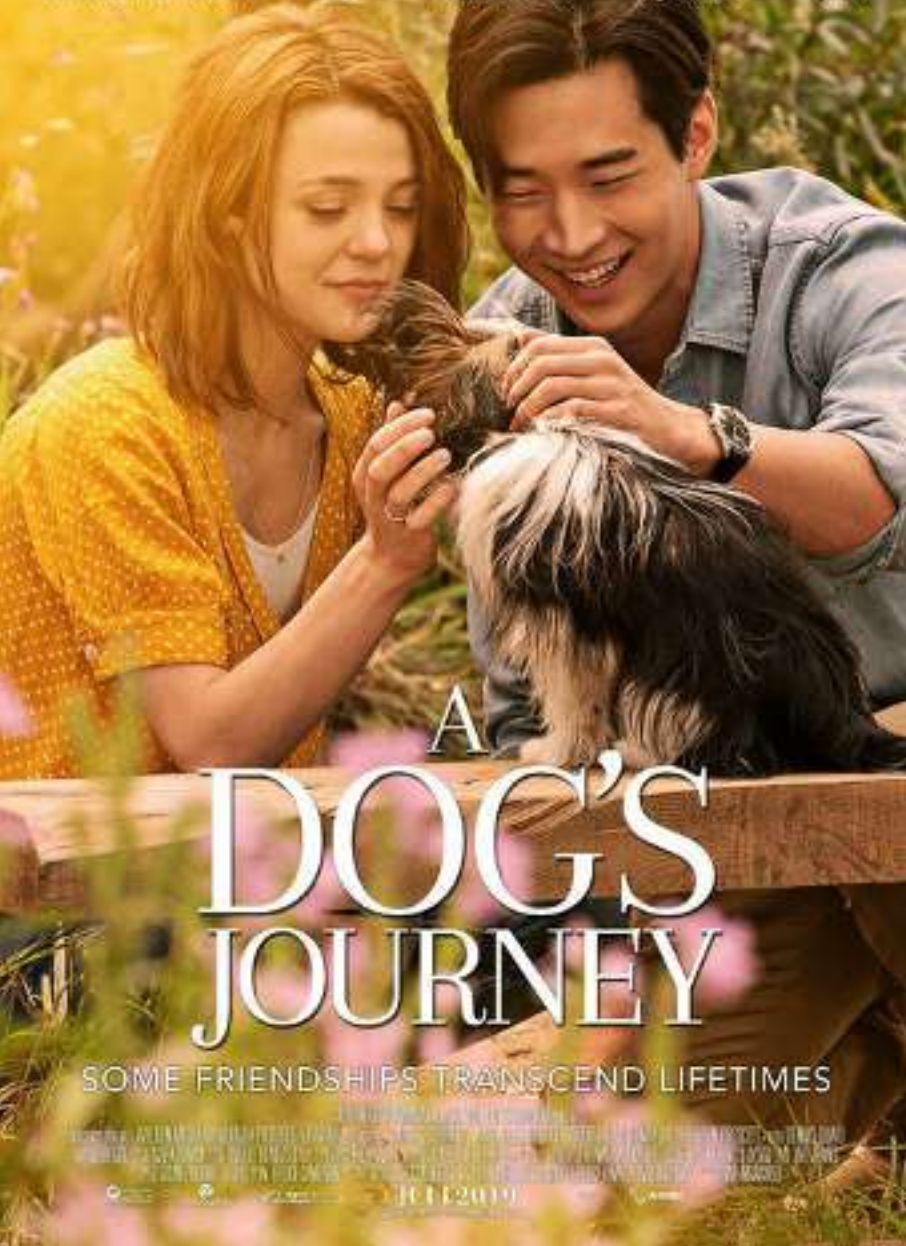

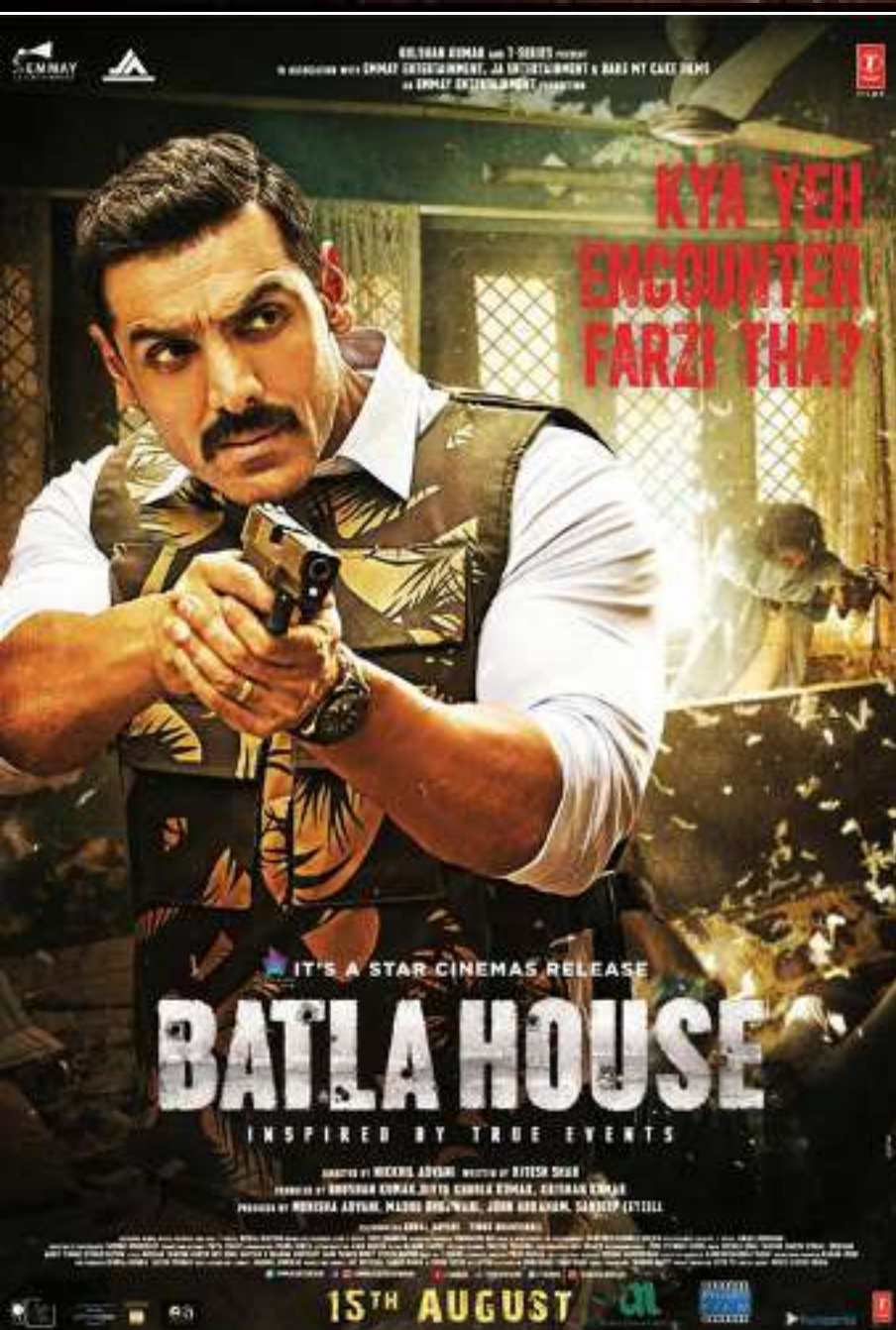

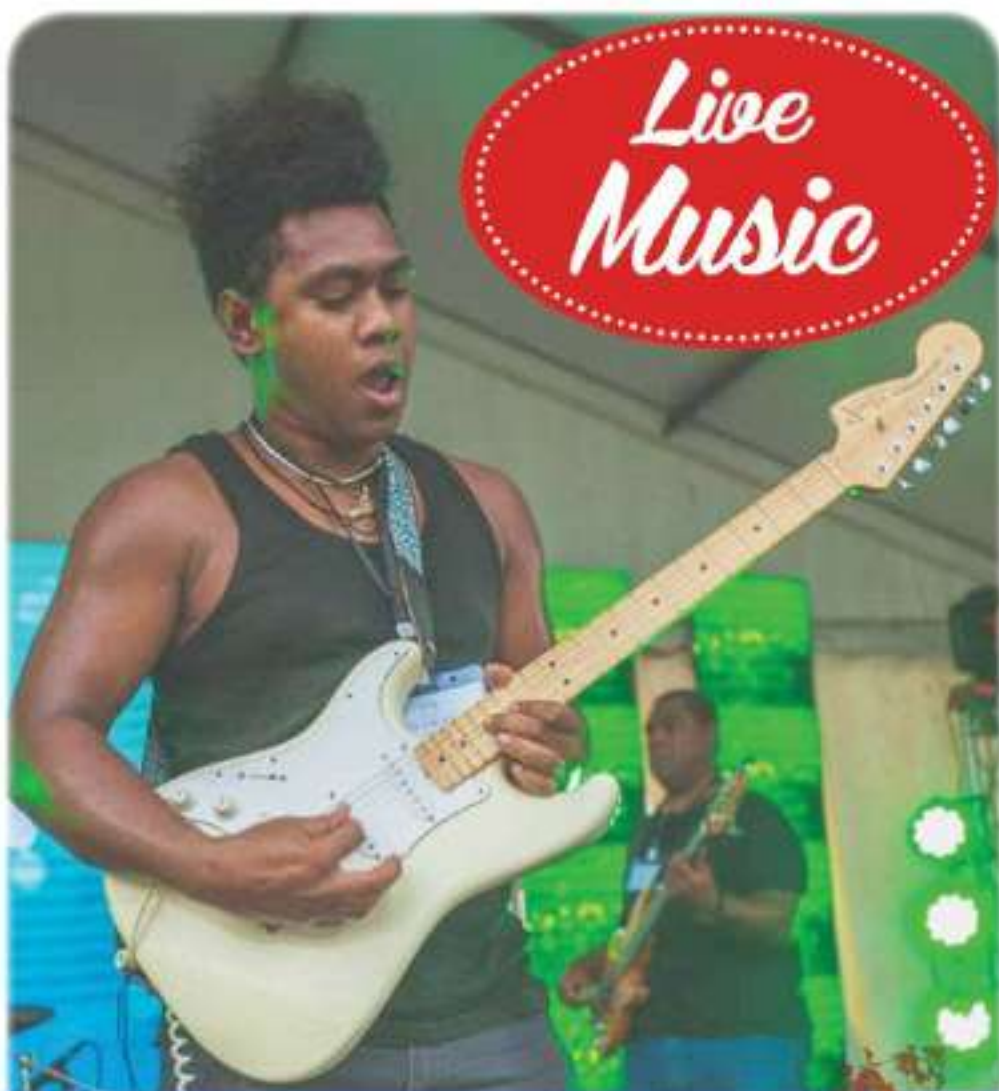
